



Elementary Dress Code 2011-2012

Polo Shirts

- Long or short-sleeved
- May be striped or solid colored
- Logos, slogans, pictures, or writing are unacceptable
 - All logos must be covered with an ICS patch
 - ICS patches must be sewn on within 2 days
- Must be long enough that the midriff and undergarments [underwear/bras] never show
- Turtleneck shirts may *only* be worn under polo shirts

Sweaters/Sweatshirts

- May be striped or solid color
- Polo shirts must be worn under sweatshirts
- Hoodies are acceptable
 - may be pullover or zipper style
 - HOODS MAY NOT BE UP DURING SCHOOL DAY
- Logos, slogans, pictures, or writing are unacceptable
 - Any logo must be covered with an ICS patch
 - ICS patches must be sewn on within 2 days

Slacks

- Must be dress style or corduroy material
 - jean material is not acceptable
- Any color is acceptable – no words, logos, embroidery, or pictures
- Unacceptable
 - Baggy pants may not be worn – teacher discretion will be used
 - Hip hugger or low rider style pants may not be worn [skin may not show]

Shorts

- Dress style shorts may be worn between April 15 – October 31
- Length: Shorts must be no shorter than 4 fingers above the knee

***NOTE:** Skirts and Jumpers are no longer part of the Elementary Dress Code.

Other Guidelines

- Closed shoes or tennis shoes are acceptable all the time (No bathroom or house slippers are permitted). Sandal style shoes with back or back-strap may also be worn
- Students may NOT wear slogans, pictures or colored shirts under their other shirts so they show through
- No hats, caps, or hoods are to be worn in the school building at any time
- Hair should be neat and clean. No hair streaking or unnatural hair color will be allowed. Strange or unusual hair styles are not permitted.
- Female students are allowed to wear earring(s) in the ears. However, no other type of body piercing is allowed on school property or at any ICS extracurricular activities.
- Male students are not permitted to wear earring(s) or any type of body piercing on school property or at ICS extracurricular activities.
- Students are not allowed to have tattoos (temporary or permanent).

No Uniform Day Guidelines

Shirts

- See through material may not be worn
- Neckline may not extend past four fingers below the collarbone
- Straps on sleeveless shirts must be at least 2 inches (three fingers) wide

Skirts, Jumpers

- When kneeling, skirts and jumpers must touch the floor
- Slits in skirts may be one index finger in length

Dresses

- Slits may be one index finger in length
- Straps on dresses must be at least 2 inches (three fingers) wide

Slacks and Shorts

- Baggy pants are unacceptable and may not be worn – teacher discretion will be used
- Hip hugger or low rider style pants may not be worn [skin may not show]
- Length: Shorts must be no shorter than 4 fingers above the knee

***NOTE:** These guidelines may be changed at any time at the discretion of the school administration.
