



Dress Code

Shirts – Acceptable shirts include polo shirts, turtlenecks, and dress style shirts.

General Guidelines

- logos, slogans, pictures, or writing are unacceptable
- all logos must be covered with an ICS patch
 - ICS patches must be sewn on within 2 days
- see through material may not be worn
- no gaping holes between buttons
- all but the top button must be buttoned while on school property or while representing ICS at extracurricular activities
- neckline may not extend past four fingers below the collarbone
- shirts must be long enough that the midriff and undergarments [underwear/bras] never show

Polo Shirts

- may be striped or solid colored
- may be short or long-sleeved
- may be worn tucked in or un-tucked

Dress Shirts

Sweaters/Sweatshirts

- All solid color sweatshirts are acceptable
- Sweaters without logos, slogans, pictures, or writing are acceptable
- Any logo must be covered with an ICS patch
 - ICS patches must be sewn on within 2 days

- ICS team hoodies and pre-approved school hoodies are acceptable. All other hoodies are unacceptable **UNLESS** they are solid colored
- Hoodies may be pullover or zipper style
- HOODS MAY NOT BE UP DURING SCHOOL DAY

Skirts, Jumpers, & Capris

General Guidelines

- When kneeling, skirts and jumpers must touch the floor
- Slits in skirts may be one index finger in length
- Dress style capris may be worn [no cargo, no jean material]

Dresses

General Guidelines

- Dresses are acceptable
- Dresses must have sleeves
- Slits may be one index finger in length

Pants

General Guidelines

- Must be dress style material
- Dress corduroy is acceptable
- Any color is acceptable – no words, logos, or pictures
- Baggy pants are unacceptable and may not be worn – teacher discretion will be used
- If dress shirts are worn, belts must be worn – Men specific
- Hip hugger or low rider style pants may not be worn [skin may not show]

Shorts

General Guidelines

- Dress style shorts may be worn between April 15 – October 31
- Length: Shorts must be no shorter than 4 fingers above the knee

Other Guidelines

- Closed shoes or tennis shoes are acceptable all the time (No bathroom or house slippers are permitted) sandal style shoes with back or back-strap may also be worn
- Students may **NOT** wear slogans, pictures or colored shirts under their other shirts so they show through
- No hats caps, or hood are to be worn in the school building at any time
- Hair should be neat and clean. No hair streaking or unnatural hair color will be allowed. Strange or unusual hair styles are not permitted
- Female students are allowed to wear earring(s) in the ears. However, no other type of body piercing is allowed on school property or at any ICS extracurricular activities
- Male students are not permitted to wear earring(s) or any type of body piercing on school property or at ICS extracurricular activities

- Students are not allowed to have tattoos (temporary or permanent)

***NOTE:** These guidelines may be changed at any time at the discretion of the school administration
