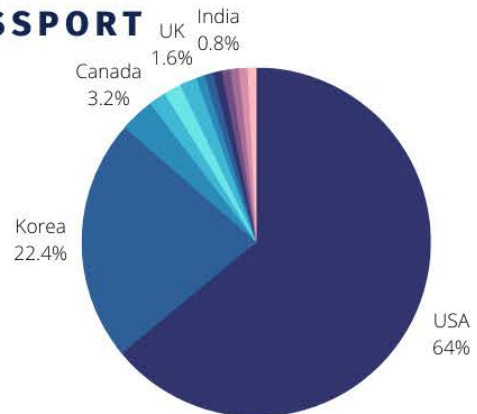


ABOUT ICS-PYEONGTAEK

GRADING AND GPA

- GPA at ICSP includes all high school courses taken at ICSP, but not transfer grades from other schools, except ICSP faculty-proctored NorthStar Academy courses. ICSP does not report any class ranking. In grades 9 through 12, one-half credit (0.5) is awarded for each semester course with a passing grade of 62% or higher.
- Grades earned in AP courses with official AP Exam score results are weighted an additional full point.

HIGH PERFORMANCE ON AP AND SAT EXAMS

- In 2021-2022, 63% of Juniors and Seniors took AP classes and exams.
- In the 2022 class, students scored 4's & 5's on the following AP exams: Computer Science Principles, English Literature, and US History
- 29% of the Class of 2022 earned 'AP Scholar' designations, including one 'AP Scholar with Distinction' awards.
